Restoration Project



2015 marks the 400th anniversary of Kyiv-Mohyla Academy – Ukraine’s historic centre of higher learning , which formed the spiritual core of Ukraine for centuries, which educated Ukraine’s most prominent historical figures, contributed to development of the national spirit and identity, which was a place where history was made and which imparted its cultural influence to other lands.

2010 the year of the 395th anniversary of the Academy’s establishment, Kyiv-Mohyla Academy launched a fundraising campaign to restore the historic XVII-XIX century architectural complex located at the Kyiv-Mohyla Academy campus.

9 of 11 Academy buildings, each one a unique historical and architectural landmark representative of the most ancient part of Kyiv known as Podil, need to be rescued from decay.

Restoration of historical models of Ukrainian architecture, which comprise University's premises



11 historical architectural models:

Cookhouse of the Brotherhood Monastery (early XVII century)

The Saint Spirit (Refectory) Church (1693)

Old Academy (Mazepa's) building (1704)

The Annunciation (Congregation) Church (1740)

Seminary building (1778-1816)

The House of the Brotherhood Monastery's Hegumen (1781)

Sundial (late XVIII century)

New Academy building (1822-1825)

Cells of Brotherhood's Monastery (1823-1879)

Prothesis (1826)

The Circle (Kovnir's) building (1899)

(aka Trapezna of the Brotherhood Monastery, early XVII – XIX centuries)

Project implemented during 2005-2008

9 mln UAH raised: 7 mln from the government and 2 mln from private donors
additional funds needed – 350 thousand UAH

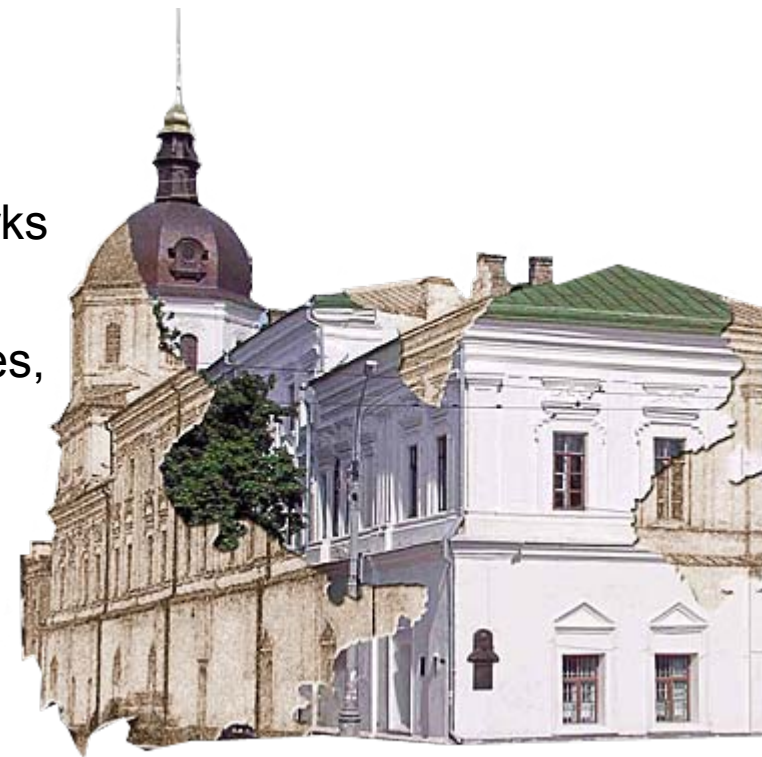


Restoration of the Old Academy (Mazepa) building

Kyiv-Mohyla Academy: Key Facts



- Kyiv-Mohyla Academy, founded in 1615, is one of the oldest universities in Eastern Europe.
- Among graduates and professors of Kyiv-Mohyla Academy there were twelve hetmans (highest state and military leaders in Ukraine's history), scientists and educators, founders of universities, libraries and churches, as well as more than 30 church hierarchs who were beatified posthumously).
- Kyiv-Mohyla Academy was re-established in 1991 by Vyacheslav Briukhovetskyi, and became the leading innovative university of Ukraine, with an international reputation for educational excellence and reform.
- Kyiv-Mohyla Academy was the first university in Ukraine to develop and implement programs according to Western educational standards (bachelor-master-doctor degrees), introduced a rating system of knowledge assessment and elective courses for students.

Kyiv-Mohyla Academy in Rankings



- Within a six month period of July 2009 – January 2010, Kyiv-Mohyla Academy improved its ranking by over 1000 positions, in the international ranking by Webometrics.
- In March 2010, the journal “Dengi” which conducted rankings of universities in Ukraine ranked Kyiv-Mohyla Academy in 1st position in humanities, 2nd position in law, and 3rd position in economics.
- In May 2009, the project “Compass” for university ranking awarded Kyiv-Mohyla Academy the 2nd position among Ukrainian institutions of higher education as ranked by students, alumni, employers, applicants and their parents

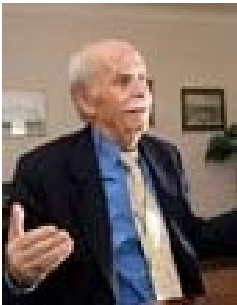


Why is the restoration necessary?



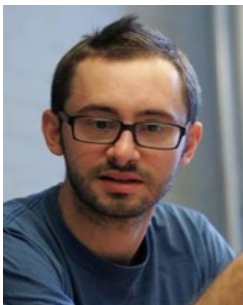

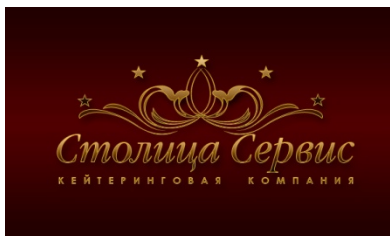
